JANUARY 8, 2010

Ferrari-Carano Vineyards

Ferrari-Carano vineyard practices are customized to match the particular characteristics of each vineyard to help the vines produce the best fruit possible, and to in turn, achieve the best wine possible.

FEBRUARY 5, 2010

Flowers Vineyards & Winery

Flowers Winery produces 15,000 cases of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from its two estate properties, as well as select vineyards in the coolest regions of the Sonoma Coast AVA, which are farmed to Flowers' specifications by their own crews. In addition to direct consumer sales, the wines are sold to fine restaurants and retailers in the US and overseas.

MARCH 5, 2010

Steele Wines

Steele Wines owns about 15% of the acreage that supplies the winery. All of the Steele Vineyards are farmed using sustainable techniques. Cover crops are planted to protect against erosion from winter rains. Some of the acreage uses a “green manure” cover crop of bell beans, peas, and barley to enrich the soil as well as holding it in place.

MAY 7, 2010

Penfold's Wines

PENFOLDS perfected the practice of multi-regional blending in the belief that overall wine quality was paramount, while at the same time recognising regionally distinctive wines like Bin 128 Coonawarra Shiraz and Bin 28 Kalimna Shiraz, both launched from the 1962 vintage, well before the trend towards regional identity took hold in the wider industry.
